

Rules and Regulations

Our goal is for everyone to have a fun and safe experience with us. To help ensure that happens, we are asking our guests to follow our regulations and rules.

- For hunting and fishing trips, a deposit of one half the price is paid upon booking your experience and is non-refundable. Your requested dates will be reserved upon receipt of this deposit. The remaining balance is due upon arrival at the lodge.
- All guests of Bridgers Creek Lodge must sign a liability waiver prior to or upon their arrival.
- All persons hunting and/or fishing who are 16 years old or older must have a valid NC hunting and/or fishing license with the appropriate game tags where applicable. These fishing and hunting licenses and tags must be visually seen by a Bridgers Creek Hunting Lodge staff member upon the customer's arrival, along with a valid ID, and kept in the guests' possession while hunting and/or fishing. Fishing and Hunting licenses and tags can be purchased online at https://www.ncwildlife.org. Hunters who are 15 years old or younger do not require a license but must be fishing or hunting with a parent or guardian.
- All persons who are 15 years old or younger can only fish or hunt with a parent or guardian who has a valid fishing or hunting license and tags. No exceptions to this policy.
- The possession or use of illegal drugs of any type is strictly prohibited while on Bridgers Creek Hunting Lodge properties.
- In order to provide a safe experience for all, guests who use prescribed drugs such as pain killers or other mind-altering drugs may not operate lodge vehicles or use a firearm while on their medication. The use of alcohol is prohibited prior to or during fishing and shooting activities.
- All persons must leave all areas of the property clean and undamaged. Any damage caused by the customer, their minor children or guest must be repaired or replaced at the expense of the customer. Modifications of any kind to the lodge or tree stands are not allowed.
- All persons must follow and abide by all NC state and federal laws while on Bridgers Creek Hunting Lodge property.
- Limits set forth by the NC Wildlife Resources Commission must be followed.
- Safety is a number one priority for having a pleasurable experience at Bridgers Creek Hunting Lodge. Therefore, all firearms must be unloaded and properly stored while on our property except during hunting or shooting activities. Do not walk with loaded guns or bows of any type. Loaded firearms are not allowed inside lodge facilities other than blinds or stands.

Violation of any of these rules and regulations could result in the immediate end of your hunting or fishing experience without any refund of unused booked time and violators will be required to leave the lodge and property.
